IV. HIGHLIGHTS OF CSR CAMIGUIN

October 23, 2015

- Shrine of Divine Mercy
 - Located at the hills in El Salvador, Misamis Oriental, the Divine Mercy shrine serves as a holy place of Worship for devotees. Completed in 2008, the 50 foot statue of Jesus Christ has become a major tourist attraction that has been drawing pilgrims and tourists alike.
- Guiob Church Ruins
 - Built in the 16th Century, the Old Guiob Church Ruins is one of the oldest and most unique structures in Camiguin. The Church was turned into ruins in the 1870's with the eruption of Mt. Vulcan. Today remnants of its characteristic coral stone structures serve as a place of worship for nearby locals.
- Sunken Cemetery
 - The Sunken Cemetery marks the remains of the old town of Catarman. The 1871 eruption of Mt. Vulcan submerged the whole town. The large cross that was built has served the town's people as well as the tourists; it's a scenic spot to memorialize the departed.

October 24, 2015

- Lanzones Festival (street dance competition)
 - The event is held every third week of October in the town of Mambajao. This is in celebration of the Lanzones fruit which is the most important livelihood in the island. TPB employees witnessed the weekend street dancing competition that showcased the vibrant culture and heritage of the place through their costumes and dance.
- Katibawasan Falls
 - Located at the foot of Mt. Timpoong, is the Katibawasan Falls. At 250 feet high, this clear stream of cool waters is what attracts the locals and tourists for a refreshing swim. The area was developed and is maintained by the local government with the provision of picnic tables, seats and cookout facilities that enhances the local tourism industry.
- Mangrove planting at Queobe Eco-park and Training Center
 - The Queobe Eco-park and Training Center located at Mahinog town, is a project of the local government that is aimed at pursuing sustainable ecological tourism. The eco-park gives emphasis on safeguarding and conserving the bio-diversity in the mangrove area. Here TPB employees assisted in this endeavor by conducting a mangrove planting activity. They have also been made aware of the importance of mangroves, and how they serve as protection of shorelines from damaging storm and floods. Furthermore, they maintain water quality and clarity by filtering pollutants.

October 25, 2015

- White Island
 - This C-shaped sandbar is among the most popular tourist destination in Camiguin. The sandbar is surrounded by colorful coral reefs on one side and by “black corals” on the other. This makes it a popular diving site for tourists.

October 26, 2015

- CDO Whitewater River Rafting and cleanup activity
 - Cagayan de Oro is famous for its Whitewater Rafting activities. The Cagayan River, with its depth and rock formations offers quite a fun and exciting experience for tourists. Having 21 rapids to conquer, the river offers a one of a kind thrilling adventure. After experiencing the excitement of Whitewater Rafting, TPB employees conducted a cleanup activity at the perimeter of the river rafting outpost. Here, TPB employees picked up the litter and trash that have been left behind by tourists and locals.

V. ISSUES AND CONCERNS/ OBSERVATIONS

- Proper disposal of wastes in the divine mercy shrine and Cagayan River
 - As tourism destinations become more popular, waste disposal becomes a serious problem. Unfortunately, the tourist areas we visited are no exemption to this circumstance. Trash and litter were apparent in the Divine Mercy Shrine, in the Cagayan River, and in the White Island of Camiguin. Most of the garbage found are food wrappers, beverage containers and other plastic materials that are usually brought about by increased tourist activities. It is essential that with the increase in tourism growth in these destinations, proper waste management be practiced.
- Carrying capacity of White Island in Camiguin
 - The White Island of Camiguin is a well-known uninhabited white sandbar. However, upon our visit the peaceful and tranquil was nowhere to be found. Instead, what greeted us upon our arrival was a crowded sandbar full of tourists and merchants. Not only that but small temporary structures for stores have also been built along on the island. It is recommended that the carrying capacity of the island be observed. Surpassing the carrying capacity of the island could risk environmental degradation and exploitation of resources. Furthermore, this could cause damage to the marine ecosystem that could negatively affect tourism in this destination.

VI. RECOMMENDATIONS

As the saying goes, “change cannot happen overnight”. For the overall improvement of the TPB’s Fun Goes Green Program, it is highly suggested that the program concentrate its efforts and resources in a specific ecotourism issue and perhaps in a specific location or tourism destination. In order for the CSR program to really make an impact continuous effort and commitment is needed. Partnering with a specific charitable institution or any other non-governmental organization (NGOs) could also be explored.

Bringing to the attention of the DOT Regional Offices and concerned LGU Tourism Offices the observations that we have encountered in the implementation of these CSR activities can also help in our efforts in preserving the sustainability of the destination.

VII. BENEFITS

- Environmental and cultural awareness among participants of the CSR activity that will help in the individual appreciation of the importance of green tourism that will hopefully transcend to their respective circle of friends and families;
- Additional first-hand knowledge of the country’s tourism products and services that will hopefully help them in becoming more productive employees of the Corporation;
- Additional “specialist” of a certain products/destination who will then promote their first – hand experience among their social circles thus encouraging domestic travel
