CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY AND TURISMO PAMASKO SA BATA (TPBATA) PROGRAM: Assistance to the Pediatric Cancer Patients in Bahay Aruga 20 December 2023

I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In time for the Holiday Season, TPB had the opportunity to give back to the community through a program collaboration of the Personnel and Human Resources Development Division's Turismo Pamasko sa mga Bata (TPB) and the Corporate Planning Business Development Department's Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). The project beneficiary is Bahay Aruga- a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) that offers temporary shelter for children afflicted with different kinds of cancer.

As an NGO, Bahay Aruga is sustained only through kind-hearted sponsors, regular donors, and through the word of mouth. In the spirit of Christmas, TPB turned-over some grocery items such as sacks of rice, milk, and hygiene products as well as, medical supplies and vitamins to Bahay Aruga on 20 December 2023. The turn-over program started with the distribution of the home-cooked food packs to the patients, their guardians, and the staff and volunteers of Bahay Aruga. For dessert, the kids enjoyed some ice cream pops. The food packs also came with small gifts for the patients. The TPB volunteers had the chance to interact with the patients during the distribution as they call the kids' names one by one to give their gifts. Aside from the donated items and the meals, a total of Php7,507.00 of voluntary monetary contributions collected from the TPB employees was also handed over to the shelter. To express their gratitude, the patients performed a Christmas Carol and sang "Star ng Pasko".

Ms. Jean of Bahay Aruga shared that some of the patients paints in their free time and these painting sessions can help them take their mind off their medical situations. Their artworks are displayed in the venue and are up for sale with 100% of the sales goes to the painter. Some volunteers bought paintings not just to help these patients, but because of the stories of the paintings that were written at the back.

Since visitors are only allowed to stay in the shelter for an hour, we ended the program with a quick group photo and a receipt of the Certificate of Donation. Ms. Jean also sent the message below to all the TPB staff and officers:

"Sobrang sobrang pasasalamat po Mam sa napaka daming blessings na ibinigay nyo po. Taos pusong pasasalamat po sa pagpapasaya sa mga patients kahit sa kaunting oras at sa masarap na pagkain nabusog po ang lahat. Maraming maraming salamat po talaga mam. God Bless po sainyong lahat."

II. BACKGROUND

Bahay Aruga is a free halfway house for cancer patients receiving treatment at the Philippine General Hospital (PGH). It was conceptualized by Ms. Marietta Bonilla in January 2014. However, the matriarch passed away recently due to the COVID-19 virus. Despite this, the shelter continues to operate with 27 patients currently in their care. According to Bahay Aruga, the children housed in the shelter were endorsed by the Oncology Department of the PGH and are within the age range of 0-18 years old. These patients are being cared for by a parent/caregiver, depending on the child's condition. The shelter provides free accommodation, food, and on occasions when PGH is not able to provide, they also shoulder

the medications. As cancer treatments can often be very difficult-mentally, emotionally, and financially for the patients and their families, through Ba hay Aruga's, the family system is given utmost consideration to make the patients' stay comfortable and the care workable.

Apart from this core support, other service offerings are available such as programs for the in-house patients e.g., painting sessions, to encourage them to go out of their comfort zones and to not dwell on their medical conditions. Bahay Aruga upholds that each child has an innate talent and each one has a way of expressing emotions through drawing with lines, painting with colors, and creating images. They also recently launched a training for parents/carers in baking goods that can aid them in sustaining basic needs upon return to their respective provinces.

As Bahay Aruga relies on donors for their necessities, TPB's donations will be a great help for their daily operations.

III. OBJECTIVES

- To engage in PPAs that increase the environmental awareness, respect for nature, and appreciation of local culture and heritage of its stakeholders.
- To comply with GCG's Memorandum Circulars 2012-07 and 2015-07 which mandates GOCCs to undertake activities on interaction with communities and have a corporate social responsibility report as socially responsible and good corporate citizens.
- To cultivate the culture of giving and volunteerism among TPB personnel

IV. TARGETS AND VOLUNTEERS

From the 15 TPB volunteers, there were 6 Female and 9 Male who participated in this program.

Per the updated list from Bahay Aruga, as of 22 December 2023, they have 27 patients in their care and 27 guardians, and 10 staff/volunteers of the shelter.


